SOLUTION

Explain concisely what you are doing about the problem. What is the unique value your organization brings to the table here?

ACTION

Does your organization's approach match the scale of the problem? Close with an invitation to your listeners to be part of your solution. What can your audience do to engage, assist, or support your work?

It's not about "dumbing down" your work – it's about **opening it up** so that others find it relevant and interesting.
